Use only document Instructions2018.doc with predefined styles for typewritten manuscript. This document can be load from

1. INTRODUCTION

The electronic form of the manuscript (Word and PDF version) should be submitted to the Conference Secretariat by e-mail no later than November 5, 2018:

The manuscript must be written in English and should not exceed 8 pages in A4 format including figures, tables, references and illustrations.

The margins of the manuscript should be: top, bottom and left 2cm each, and right 1cm. The manuscript should not end at the beginning of a new page. If the last page of the manuscript is not full, the text should be divided into two columns of the same length.

2. SUBHEADING (E.G. METHODOLOGY)

Use the following styles for manuscript typewriting:

- Title of paper **Paper title** (Font: Times New Roman, Bold, All caps, 14pts, Spacing: before 18pts, after 6pts, Alignment: centered).
- Name of authors Author name (Font: Times New Roman, Italic, 12pts, Spacing: before – 0pts, after – 12pts, Alignment: centered).
- The company/institute name and authors' addresses should be typed in the footnotes **Footnote text** (Font: Times New Roman, Italic, 10pts, Spacing: before 0pts, after 3pts, Alignment: left).
- Abstract at the manuscript beginning Abstract (Font: Times New Roman, Italic, 10pts, Spacing: before – 0pts, after – 3pts, Alignment: justified).
 Bold text – Abstract.

- The other part of the manuscript should be typed in two columns spaced with 5mm using the style Normal (Font: Times New Roman, Italic, 10pts, Spacing: before 0pts, after 3pts, Alignment: justified).
- Use three levels of headings maximum. Heading 1 (Font: Arial, Bold, All caps, 10pts, Spacing: before 12pts, after 3pts, Alignment: left), Heading 2 (Font: Arial, Bold, 10pts, Spacing: before 6pts, after 3pts, Alignment: left), Heading 3 (Font: Arial, BoldItalic, 10pts, Spacing: before 6pts, after 3pts, Alignment: left).

2.1 Subheading (e.g. results)




Fig. 1 Font styles for typewriting equation




Fig. 2 Font sizes for typewriting equation

The equations are typed in one column using styles and sizes given in these gudelines and explained in Fig. 1 and Fig. 2. They should be marked at the right margin with formating paragraph using styles – **Equation** (Font: Times New Roman, 10pts, Spacing: before – 3pts, after – 3pts, Alignment: centered, Tabs: 4.85cm centered, 8.75cm left), such as:

$$\left(\frac{\partial n}{\partial t}\right)_{x} - V(t)\left(\frac{\partial n}{\partial t}\right)_{t} = f - (f + g)n \tag{1}$$

If they are too long, the equations can be typed in two columns.

2.1.1 Subheading (e.g. conclusion)

Figure captions should be formatted using the style – **Picture title** (Font: Times New Roman, Italic, 10pts, Spacing: before – 3pts, after – 3pts, Alignment: centered). Bold only sign of figures.

The illustrations (tables, figures, etc.) can be larger than one column. Caption for tables are typed above the tables in the right corner with formatting paragraph using the style **Table title** (Font: Times New Roman, Italic, 10pts, Spacing: before – 3pts, after – 3pts, Alignment: left). Bold only sign of tables.

The paragraphs with the text or other illustrations that are immediately under the figure or table should be additionally formatted with 6pts spacing before.
